**ADDENDUM TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "AGREEMENT") DATED ..... DAY OF MARCH 2023, BETWEEN KEONAMEX PETROLEUM NIG LTD ("KEONAMEX") AND N. U. SYNERGY LIMITED ("N.U. SYNERGY")**

**THIS ADDENDUM** is dated this ..... day of March 2023

Keonamex and N.U. Synergy are individually referred to as a 'Party' and collectively as the 'Parties'.

**BACKGROUND:**

1. The Parties executed the Agreement to outline terms for collaboration in the storage, sales and distribution of petroleum products allocated by the Nigerian Midstream and Downstream Petroleum Regulatory Authority (NMDPRA) through the NTL Portal and marketing through Keonamex's terminal at Warri, Delta State.
2. Consequently, the Parties has agreed as follows:
  - a. Keonamex shall apply for petroleum product (PMS) through the NTL portal separately for both parties and N.U. Synergy shall be saddled with the responsibility of networking the processing approval, product allocation and programming for the allocated products.
  - b. N.U. Synergy shall furnish Keonamex with all information relating to the processing approval, programming of its allocated products PFI.
  - c. Each party shall be responsible for their expenses arising from the approved PFI.
  - d. This Addendum is the first and only amendment to the Agreement as of the date stated above.

**NO OTHER CHANGES**

Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Addendum, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and are in full force and effect.

In the event that any dispute or differences arises out of this MOU or in relation thereto including any dispute relating to validity or effect, parties herein shall use their best endeavour to settle it BUT if parties herein are unable to agree on a settlement, they shall jointly agree on an Arbitrator and the proceedings shall be in accordance with the law in Nigeria PROVIDED that this shall not prejudice any legal actions or enforceable rights that the aggrieved party may be entitled to.


